Day 01: Hanoi Arrival - Welcome & Airport Pick-up (No Meal)

Xin Chao! Welcome to Hanoi City – Capital of thousand years of civilization, Vietnam.

At Noi Bai Airport, your private guide and driver will meet you outside the arrivals lounge with a welcome sign and transfer you to your hotel. Check-in time is 14:00, so early room access may not be available. Your guide will share details of your stay and answer any questions. The rest of the day is free at leisure.

Overnight: in Hanoi. Meal Included: No Meal.

Accommodation: 4 stars hotels as mentioned or similar.

Transfer: Private vehicle and driver.

Tour Guide: Shared English-Speaking tour guide.

Day 02: Hanoi - Day at Leisure (Breakfast)

Enjoy a leisurely day in Hanoi, Vietnam's captivating city.

Start with a relaxed breakfast at a local café and observe the lively street scene. Take a leisurely walk around Hoan Kiem Lake and visit Ngoc Son Temple. Explore the charming Old Quarter with its markets and street food stalls. Treat yourself to a rejuvenating massage or spa treatment.

Enjoy sunset views from a rooftop bar or café. End the day with a delicious dinner at a local restaurant, savoring the flavors of Vietnamese cuisine. Experience the laid-back charm of Hanoi on this leisurely day.

+ Optional 1: Join Medium Group Option (with 20 – 30 pax maximum) – SIC

Breakfast is at your hotel.





08.00 – 08.30 AM Our Tour guide and driver will pick up at your hotel and start to discover Hanoi City. 08.45 AM Visit Ho Chi Minh Complex, the final resting place of Vietnamese great father or Uncle Ho. You have a chance to see the embalmed body of Ho Chi Minh then walk around the garden to see 2 houses where he lived & worked from 1954 to 1969.

Then visit One Pillar Pagoda where worships the Goddess of Mercy – It is the most unique pagoda in the world.

10.15 AM Visit Vietnam Ethnology Museum to learn about the culture of 54 ethnic groups living in the whole country of Vietnam.

12.30 – 12.45 PM Have lunch at the local restaurant. You have an opportunity to enjoy Vietnamese cuisine. Vegetarian food is available as well.

13.30 PM Visit Tran Quoc Pagoda located on Golden Fish Island in West Lake. It is the oldest pagoda in Hanoi built in the 6th century.

14.30 PM Continue to visit Temple of Literature – the first university of Vietnam, The Temple of Literature (Van Mieu Quoc Tu Giam) is one of the most attractive tourist spots in Northern Vietnam. The Temple of Literature was founded in 1070.

15.30 PM Keep going to visit Hoa Lo Prison, the prison was built by the French, from 1886 to 1901, when Vietnam was still a part of French Indochina. The French called the prison Maison Centrale. The prison was called "A Hell on Earth" and now the prison is like a war museum for those who want to understand more about the war against France of Vietnamese people.

16.30 PM Then, our driver will take you back to the hotel.

- When visiting Ho Chi Minh, Vietnam's esteemed leader, it is important to dress respectfully. Please wear attire that covers your knees and shoulders, which means avoiding shorts, sleeveless tops, miniskirts, sleeveless T-shirts or hats. Kindly note that photography is not permitted inside the premises.
- Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum is closed on Mondays and Fridays. But you still can take pictures of the Mausoleum and visit that area.
- Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum is closed at least 2 months (15th June 15th August) for the annual maintaining.
- You should bring the necessary things such as cash, cellphone or cameras, raincoat/ umbrella, sun block,
 etc... (depending on the weather)
- The itinerary can be changed depending on the situation.
- + Optional 2: Quang Phu Cau Incense Village & Hanoi Train Street (SIC):

Departure & Arrival time: 07.30 – 12.00 noon

After your breakfast at the hotel, we will pick you up and take you to Quang Phu Cau Incense Village with activities:

Explore the village: Take a walk through the traditional village.

Learn incense-making: Understand how incense is made traditionally, from bamboo to the final product.

Meet locals: Listen to stories about incense-making.

Take photos: Capture colourful incense-making moments.

Leave Quang Phu Cau Incense Village to visit Hanoi's Train Street for egg coffee tasting and watching the train pass through.

Finally, we will return you to your hotel in Hanoi, concluding the tour.

+ Optional 3: Hanoi Evening Street Food Walking Tour - Private Tour

Your English-speaking local guide will give you an insight into the intricacies and traditions of Vietnamese food culture including details on ingredients and historical backgrounds of popular northern dishes. We eat as we go, sampling tasty Hanoian street food from a street cart.

Walking through the maze of bustling streets that make up Hanoi's Old Quarter, we tempt our tastebuds with the famed Hanoi dish Bun Cha Ta, Nem Ran, Pho...at a local eatery. Watch in awe as the skilled chefs demonstrate for you how this tasty dish is put together. Continuing into the atmospheric heart of the Old Quarter, we wander past street stalls and quiet residential lanes where you can observe local life that has changed little since Hanoi was founded over 1000 years ago.

Now, it's time for dessert as we venture down a small alley to join in the local tradition of feasting on fresh fruit served in a cup and smothered with crushed iced and condensed milk – this specialty is one not to be missed!



Your local guide will then take you to one of Hanoi's best kept secrets, a hidden café inside the old quarter. This hard-to-find café is one of the few left in the city that still serves egg coffee, a scrumptious local delicacy that we will sample whilst admiring the hustle and bustle of the city center below. Or, if coffee is not your style, a cold beer awaits!

At the end of our Hanoi Street food tour, you are free to continue exploring the area or your guide will assist you with directions or a taxi back to your hotel.

Morning

07.45 – 08.15 AM Pick up at your hotel's lobby. Then visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum to explore the architectural and historical aspects of Uncle Ho's final resting-place. Just next door is Ho Chi Minh's house on stilts and lying to one side of the Mausoleum is the One Pillar Pagoda, which was founded by King Ly Thai To in 1049 – the structure has become an important symbol for the people of Hanoi. the Literature Temple and Quoc Tu Giam, see Vietnam's first university, constructed in 1070 – it's gardens and well-preserved architecture will offer a relaxing glimpse into Vietnam's past.

Afternoon

After lunch, proceed to visit the Ethnology Museum (available on Sun, Tue, Thu & Sat only). Take you past Hoan Kiem Lake to see the peaceful waters. and the beauty of Ngoc Son temple. In the end, journey through Hanoi's Old Quarter, where you will then have a chance for some shopping and exploration. The tour ends around 15.30 – 16.00 PM.

Day 03: Hanoi - Ninh Binh, Mua Cave & Mountain - River Boating in Trang An, a Destination of Wonders - SIC (Breakfast / Lunch)

07.15 – 08.00 AM Our shared tour guide will pick you up from your hotel. We will take you to Ninh Binh province which is about 120 km far from Hanoi Old Quarter.

09.00 – 09.15 AM Have a short break for 15 – 20 minutes to relax.

10.15 – 10.30 AM Start cycling 20 minutes to Hoa Lu ancient capital, then park the bicycle and walk to visit Hoa Lu. This is the first capital of Vietnam, you will be impressed by the outstanding architecture when entering temples of King Dinh and King Le, the first and second emperors of ancient Vietnam, built in the 17th century. 11.30 AM Continue cycling tour 30 minutes more around the village to discover the life of local people and come back to the restaurant*.

12.00 noon Have a lunch in the local restaurant. You can have a panoramic view of the poetic mountain and river scenery of Ninh Binh while enjoying the delicious foods. Vegetarian food is always available (please inform us in advance).

13.00 – 13.30 PM Visit Trang An, a World Heritage Site recognized by UNESCO in 2014. There, you can spend 1.5 – 2 hours on the boat ride to enjoy the beauty of this place, which has a beautiful tunnel cave system and appears in the New Version of Kong in 2016 – "Skull Island".

16.00 – 16.30 PM Get back to the bus then leave for Mua Cave (Dancing Cave). Walk up almost 500 steps, you can reach the top of Lying Dragon Mountain & have an amazing panoramic view of Tam Coc from here. 17.00 – 17.30 PM Get on the taxi to go to your hotel in Ninh Binh. Check into your hotel and the rest of the day is your leisure time.

- If you do not prefer to cycle, we will transfer you by bus to Hoa Lu, where our tour guide will meet you and guide you to the temples. After the visit, we will transfer you back to the restaurant.

Day 07: Hue - Imperial Citadel Sightseeing (SIC) (Breakfast / Lunch)

Today you will explore the royal city of Hue once served as an imperial capital to the Nguyen Lords, a feudal dynasty which reigned from 1802 to 1945. With splendid emperors' tombs, ancient pagodas, and the remains of the citadel, the city retains its royal charm.

08:00 – 08:30 Pick up at hotel, enjoy a dragon boat trip along the Perfume River to Thien Mu Pagoda, the oldest pagoda in Hue.

Continue to the Imperial Citadel, former home of the Nguyen Dynasty, then stroll through the bustling Dong Ba Market before lunch with traditional Hue specialties.

In the afternoon, visit the majestic Minh Mang Tomb and the unique Khai Dinh Tomb with its French-influenced design. Afterwards, stop at Xuan Thuy Village to see local families making conical hats and colorful incense sticks – perfect for photos.

16:30 Return to hotel.

Then, check out of your hotel and the private driver (without tour guide) will take you to the Hue. On the way, there will be a 10-minutes pause at Lang Co Station for visitors to enjoy Lang Co Bay.

Winding sections, great mountains, extensive seas, lagoons, and elegant coastlines stirring the best excitement for all trippers.

Apart from small but unique rural sites scattered along the way, you will pass by the top 3 attractions in Hue and Da Nang: Hai Van Pass, Lang Co Bay and Tam Giang Lagoon System.

Upon arrival in Hoi An, check into your hotel and your time is leisure.

+ Option2: Central Heritage Connection by Day Train to Da Nang, then transfer to Hoi An by private car

Our guide will meet you at your hotel in Hue and accompany you to the train station. Board the Central Heritage Line Train and enjoy one of the most scenic rail journeys in Vietnam. Travel south towards Da Nang, passing through lush green mountains, emerald lagoons, peaceful fishing villages, and the spectacular Hai Van Pass with breathtaking views over the coastline.

Upon arrival in Da Nang, our driver will meet you at the train station for a private transfer to Hoi An. Check in at your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to explore the charming Ancient Town.

Day 9 & 10 : Hoi An - Day at Leisure (Breakfast)

Spend your 02 full days to relax at your leisure in this UNESCO heritage town, which has some of the best food, architecture, and shopping in all of Vietnam.





Hoi An is the perfect place to potter around, shop at many tailor stores, and dine at the town's fabulous restaurants. In this town, you can get a suit/ tuxedo made within 24 hours at a reasonable price.

You can also take an opportunity to join a cooking class to learn about the arts of Vietnam culinary; visiting the local market, choosing ingredients and preparing and cooking Hoi An special dishes. This is great fun.

Overnight: in Hoi An.

Day 11: Hoi An - Transfer to Da Nang - Flight to Ho Chi Minh City (Breakfast)

Domestic Flight: Inclusive with Vietnam Airlines.

The morning will be free for relaxing at the beach or hotel, strolling or shopping in the ancient town or whatever takes your fancy before checking out hotel at check-out time.

Then, we will depart Hoi An ancient town and head to Da Nang International Airport for a next flight to Ho Chi Minh City – The City That Never Sleeps, still called Saigon by the locals. It's the largest city in Vietnam and located near the Mekong Delta.

Upon arrival, you will be met by a new private driver and tour guide who will drive you to the hotel in the city center for check in. The rest of the day is leisurely.

Overnight: in Ho Chi Minh City. Meal Included: Breakfast at hotel.

Accommodation: 4 stars hotels as mentioned or similar.

Transfer: Private vehicle and driver.

Tour Guide: Shared English-Speaking tour guide.

Day 12: Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi Tunnels - City's Highlights Sightseeing (SIC) (Breakfast / Lunch)

Join Small Group Option (with 10 – 12 pax maximum)

After breakfast, visit Ho Chi Minh City's landmarks: Independence Palace (historic former royal palace), Notre Dame Cathedral (French colonial architecture), Central Post Office (iconic colonial building), and War Remnants Museum (displays on Vietnam and Indochina wars). Lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon,



drive to Cu Chi Tunnels to explore the underground network used during the war, including living quarters, storage, and traps. Enjoy tea and cassava, with optional shooting experience, then return to Saigon.

Start early with a boat trip to the famous Cai Rang Floating Market, bustling with boats selling fruits, vegetables, and local products. Stop at a boat to try vermicelli and coffee, then visit a rice noodle factory and a local market. After arriving at Sapa and checking into your hotel, take the rest for a while and then, your private guide and driver will meet you at hotel's lobby to take you walking on a small path down the valley to Y Linh Ho village settled down by the Muong Hoa River and from here to the Black H'mong village of Lao Chai. Black H'mong is one of the biggest minority groups in the Sapa area. They are proud of their culture and keep their traditions and way of living. They have their own language and wear traditional indigo blue clothing. The H'mong people have just recently changed their living way from a sifting style into a sedentary one. So, there are still a lot of traces of the past time can be seen: rudimentary houses, stone wall around homes...

After this, you continue to Ta Van village (1.200 m) to visit Zay people. Zay is a fairly small minority group of about 38.000 people who live mainly in the mountains in Northwest Vietnam. The development has meant that

some of their old customs have been lost but many women still wear traditional shirts with a purple, blue or green colour. The Zay houses are built of wood and bamboo with a clay floor.
