Itinerary

Day 1: Sydney / Melbourne / Perth - Siem Reap Arrival (No Meal)

Your Vietnam and Cambodia adventure begins with connecting flight from Australia to Cambodia (via Saigon with Vietnam Airlines). Upon arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, process the immigration procedure, then get your luggage and walk straight to the Exit Gate where our representative is waiting. After self-introducing, you'll transfer directly to the hotel in the city for check-in (check-in time is 2 pm). Time to freshen up and relax at the hotel.

Overnight: in Siem Reap.

Meal Included: No Meal.

Accommodation: 3★, 4★, 5★ hotels as mentioned or similar.

Day 2: Siem Reap Tour (Breakfast)

Visit the antique capital of Angkor Thom (12 century): the South Gate with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk, the Bayon Temple, unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara, the Phimeanakas, the Royal Enclosure, the Elephants Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King, and Ta Prohm, one of the area's most beautiful temples. Ta Prohm has been relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery.

Visit to the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: Angkor Wat. The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Enjoy wonderful sunset from the top of Pre Rup temple.

Overnight: in Siem Reap.

Day 3: Siem Reap - Free Day (Breakfast)

Enjoy a free day at leisure.

Overnight: in Siem Reap.

Meal Included: Breakfast at hotel.

Accommodation: 3★, 4★, 5★ hotels as mentioned or similar.

Optional Tour with extra fee:

Tonle Sap Lake - Artisan D' Angkor

We will enjoy a boat ride on the Tonle Sap Lake at KAMPONG PHLUK VILLAGE. This is the largest permanent freshwater lake in Southeast Asia and flows into the Tonle Sap River, joining the Mekong in Phnom Penh. We will see a fishermen's "floating village" with floating schools, a floating police station, etc. It is the same as a big village floating on the lake, and the "village" moves from place-to-place following water levels and currents.

Lunch is not included.

In the afternoon, we go for a guided orientation at the finest Artisan Angkor wood/stone carving center, which displays various defined handicrafts and silk products, and continue to stroll around Old Market to see interesting daily trade as well as bargain for local handmade products, paintings, lacquers, carvings, clothes, traditional crafts, and so on, and you can also go to Royal Residence Garden for walking and breathtaking views.

Private tour cost will be advised with Transportation, English Speaking Tour Guide, Entrance fee, tax & service charge.

Day 4: Siem Reap - Flight to Hanoi (Breakfast)

You are free until we transfer to airport to take Vietnam Airlines flight to Hanoi. Upon arrival at Noi Bai International airport, you will be greeted by our representative and be transferred to hotel for check in. On arrival at Noi Bai airport, you will have time to explore the charming city of Hanoi, often referred to as the 'Paris of the East', with its yellow ochre colonial buildings, tree-lined boulevards and scenic lakes. Then you are free.

Overnight: in Hanoi.

Meal Included: Breakfast at hotel.

Accommodation: 3★, 4★, 5★ hotels as mentioned or similar.

Day 5: Hanoi - City Tour (SIC) (Breakfast / Lunch)

Morning:

Depart Hanoi's Old Quarter for Quang Phu Cau Incense Village, famous for its vibrant incense drying courtyards – a photographer's dream. Continue to Hanoi Train Street to witness the thrilling moment as a train passes through the narrow alley. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

Afternoon:

Visit Hoa Lo Prison (Maison Centrale), then explore the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university. Stop by the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (outside) and Ba Dinh Square, followed by Tran Quoc Pagoda by West Lake. End the day with a cup of Hanoi's signature Egg Coffee before returning to your hotel.

Remarks:

- Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and his Museum are closed on Monday, Friday, and the whole months of Oct/Nov.
- Ho Chi Minh House and all Museums are closed on Monday.

Overnight: in Hanoi.

Meal Included: Breakfast at hotel, Lunch at local restaurant.

Accommodation: 3★, 4★, 5★ hotels as mentioned or similar.

Day 6: Hanoi - Halong Bay, Overnight on Cruise (SIC) (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Pick-up at your hotel and start the scenic drive to Halong Bay. Enjoy the landscape of the countryside and a short break on the way. Embark on the cruise followed by a short cruise briefing. Savour a delectable lunch as you cruise among the limestone islands. Take a small sampan among the hidden bays around the Luon Cave. Cruise to Ti Top Island, go swimming or relaxing at the beach or climb up to the top of the island for a panorama view of Halong Bay. Enjoy the sunset with dinner. After dinner, fish for squid or just laze around.

Note: detail itinerary of cruise will be mentioned detail when the tour is confirmed. The program is subject to change based on weather conditions or administrator management.

Overnight on cruise: in Halong Bay.

Meal Included: Breakfast at hotel, Lunch and Dinner on cruise.

Day 7: Halong Bay - Hanoi - Flight to Danang (Light Breakfast / Brunch)

Flight: from 17:00 pm onward

Start your day with Tai Chi class and breakfast at sunrise. Explore the amazing Sung Sot Cave – the nicest cave in Halong Bay. Continue your cruise exploring Ba Hang fishing village, Dog Islet and more. While heading back to the harbour, watch the cooking demonstration before enjoying a traditional Vietnamese lunch.

After the cruise, you are picked up & transferred back to your hotel in Hanoi (sharing Shuttle bus).

Upon arrival in Hanoi, your private car & driver transfers you to Noi Bai airport for your flight to Danang.

Upon arrival in Danang, you are picked up & transfer to your hotel in Danang.

Today, after your breakfast, check out hotel in Danang (about 12:00 pm), you meet your driver for a private transfer to Hoi An. Enjoy the scenic coastal drive and check in at your hotel. The rest of the day is free at leisure to relax or explore the charming ancient town on your own.

Overnight: in Hoi An.

Meal Included: Breakfast at hotel.

Accommodation: 3★, 4★, 5★ hotels as mentioned or similar.

Day 10: Hoi An - Cooking Class (SIC) (Breakfast / Lunch)

This trip will take you to join a cooking class and share your great experience to go to the local market for buying fresh ingredients and cook Vietnamese traditional dishes. Besides, you will feel peaceful when visiting the beautiful vegetables gardens, having an opportunity to ride a bike or take the boat trip to discover and experience rural life.

Leave your hotel around 09:00 am in the morning, you will conquer the street along the Thu Bon River and visit Hoi An colorful market to choose ingredients and make dishes with them. Finish buying ingredients at the market, embark on a small boat to ride along the Thu Bon River (or cycle 15 minutes) for about 25 minutes to catch the cooking school on the other side of the river.

Today's activities end at around 13:00 pm and departure to your hotel. The rest of the day is your leisure time.

- After that we will head to Tra Que Vegetable Village, you can relax and enjoy the peaceful countryside then stroll along the vegetable villages. As a special treat, you will be involved with digging, sowing, planting, and harvesting the vegetables with hundreds of years of rudimentary tools of the farmers. You will enjoy E Water, a specialty of Tra Que vegetable village, you can feel the strong medicinal flavour from many kinds of vegetables. You could well be a farmer with many interesting activities.
- Secondly, you will ride your bicycle leisurely passing through the rice fields, and villages, to come to the art of making lanterns.
- You will visit craftsmen with skilful hands, show you how to create brightly coloured lanterns. Expertly guided you could make yourself a lantern as a gift to your family.
- Finish your learning, the tour guide will take you back to your hotel and finish your trip.

Cu Chi Tunnels Half Day Tour (no lunch)

Morning Tour (8:00 AM - 2:30 PM).

Hotel pickup in Ho Chi Minh City District 1 and scenic drive to Cu Chi Tunnels through countryside landscapes. Historical orientation with introductory documentary viewing providing essential background on tunnel construction and wartime significance.

Guided tunnel exploration - Navigate through the intricate underground network including living quarters, kitchens, sleeping areas, storage facilities, arms factories, medical facilities, and command posts. Discover ingenious survival techniques and cleverly camouflaged defensive systems.

Traditional wartime refreshments - Sample authentic tea and cassava that sustained guerrilla fighters during the conflict.

Optional shooting range experience featuring period weaponry (additional fees apply).

Return journey to Ho Chi Minh City with hotel drop-off.

Mekong Delta One Day Tour (with lunch)

This morning after breakfast be picked up from the hotel and traveled to the city of My Tho (approx. 1.5 hours) on the banks of the Mekong. Upon arrival, board a motorboat and cruise along the Mekong River. The boat will take you to Xep Canal, a lovely place where you can escape the traffic of the main river. Here you will cruise under coconut trees before arriving at a small islet. Disembark and walk around a small local village. Stop at a local family's home to enjoy tropical fruit, honey tea and wine and listen to traditional Vietnamese music performed by the villagers. Afterwards continue onwards to another islet where a traditional Vietnamese lunch will be prepared by a local family (included). In the afternoon return to Ho Chi Minh City and your hotel accommodation.

Included: Transportation, English Speaking Tour Guide, Mekong River Boat, Entrance Fee, Traditional Music Performance, Lunch, Honey Tea and Honey Wine, Seasonal Fruits, a bottle of water.

Day 13: Ho Chi Minh City - Free Day (Breakfast)

Today you are free for your own exploration in Ho Chi Minh City.

Overnight: in Ho Chi Minh City.

Meal Included: Breakfast at hotel.

Accommodation: 3★, 4★, 5★ hotels as mentioned or similar.

Saigon Street Food Tour by Motorbike

Please note:

- *Departure time: Flexible but 17.30 is recommended*

Our talented guide with the motorbike picks you up at your hotel (or any location requested by you). After a short riding instruction and program introduction of Night Saigon Food Tour by Motorbike, we hop on the motorbike. The guide makes sure you are ok on the motorbike before weaving around the main streets and narrow alleyways to see the city.

1st stop: We stop at over 30-year-old Bot Chien Dat Thanh – the oldest and most famous places to eat Pan-fried scrambled egg rice cake and Dumplings. Two of these foods are Saigon's specialty foods which perhaps could not be found in other regions. The guide shows you how skilfully cook fries Pan-fried scrambled egg rice on the large flat pan until crispy.

2nd stop: After that, we have a short walk on the pavement to reach an over 30-year-old restaurant to see how they grill beef wrapped in green wild betel leaf. The sweet smell can make you like to eat this food right away. The guide shows you how to eat grilled beef with rice noodles with vegetables, herbs, rice noodles, rice paper, and special sauce.

3rd stop: Passing through Nguyen Thien Thuat buildings since the 1960s, we stop at Ho Thi Ky flower market which is the biggest flower market and known as the non-sleeping market. Coming here, you have a chance to walk through alleyways lined with flower shops with thousands of colourful and sweet-smelling flowers. Trolling to Cambodian market hidden in Ho Thi Ky, you can immerse yourself into local life and learn to grill a banana girdle cake and enjoy the crispy and smelling cake.

4th stop: It is time to zip through Saigon and reach one of the oldest apartment buildings – Ngo Gia Tu buildings on Su Van Hanh Street. The area is overwhelmed with busy night street food stalls which are the favourite of locals. It is a chance to eat Coconut ice cream at a dessert shop since 1975 or eat crispy Vietnamese pancakes at a Banh xeo stall.

5th stop: Stopping at a long-standing Broken rice restaurant, we see how they grill pork on charcoal, buy a portion of Broken rice and eat at the next stop. Broken rice should not be missed on a Saigon food tour because it is a specialty food of the city. It is a perfect blend of broken rice, grilled pork, cucumber, pickles, green onion oil, fish sauce dip.

6th stop: Next, we head to District 4, a tiny humble island district separated from the city's other parts by channels and rivers. This area is the former mafia hotspot run by Nam Cam, notorious crime boss but it has become a paradise of foodies in recent years. We drive around Xom Chieu market – one of the top night street

food markets with countless stalls, foods, busy street vendors and dinners. The last and funniest stop is a restaurant in Vinh Khanh snail street where hundreds of dinners sit, eat, drink, and talk leisurely under the sky. There we enjoy the most popular dishes such as Roasted ca na snail with salt, steamed clam with lemongrass, Grilled scallop with green onion oil. We make sure that it will be fun to eat the snail and shellfish dishes. If you dare enough to try Fertilized duck egg, we are happy to help you to crack the egg and eat. If you cannot eat seafood, we will order amazing meat dishes for you. We also sip some local beers, cheer “1,2,3 dzo” like locals. Just experience the “Nhau” and “Snail eating” culture with your new friends.

Lastly, the guide returns you to your hotel. It is time to say goodbye; tour ends but memories last forever. You are welcome to customize the tour program (INCLUDING TOUR ROUTE AND FOODS) at your wish because this is a private tour. We can accommodate all food allergies, dietary restrictions, and vegetarians. Let us know your idea when you book the tour or on the tour. You can also request a female or male guide for your tour.
